



1. Obey the driver at all times and cooperate immediately.
2. Always respect others and their well-being.
3. Board the bus slowly. Use the handrails when getting on and off the bus.
4. Scuffling, fighting, graffiti, smoking and/or willful damage to the bus will not be tolerated.
5. Always remain seated facing forward while the bus is in motion.
6. Never extend a body part out of the window: arms, legs, head etc.
7. Talk quietly. No yelling. Use your library voice. Watch for the driver's signal that the noise level is too high.
8. Do not distract the driver.
9. Never throw objects inside or outside of the bus.
10. Vulgar, obscene and blasphemous language and gestures are strictly prohibited.
11. No eating or drinking on the bus. No animals of any kind and only certain equipment are permitted on school buses. The final decision as to what may or may not be transported rests with the driver.
12. Driver may assign seats to students at any time.
13. Do not cross the road until after the school bus has left the stop and you have a clear view in both directions.
14. Repeated or major Safety violations shall result in a misconduct report to the principal.
